We find that it's helpful for parents to be informed and knowledgeable about the expectations and requirements of the courses the students will be requesting, as well as have an opportunity to ask questions. In addition to this evening presentation, we will be providing students and families with a number of resources, including: student assemblies in late January; conversations with teachers, counselors, and administrators; a comprehensive Program of Studies available online; and a website with course syllabi, sample tasks, and exemplary student work examples.

Topics of the evening presentation include:

- Differences between Advanced Placement, Honors, and College Preparatory courses
- Brief overview of core curriculum areas
- Information regarding Advanced Placement courses
- Review of the Change-of-Program Policy

Once resources are allocated, we have very limited flexibility in changing schedules, so it is critical for students to make a strong commitment to courses they request.
