The application for the High School Scholarship Foundation of Fairfield, Inc. will be available on line beginning Thursday, April 5, 2018. This application is required to apply for a variety of scholarships from the Foundation and a number of local community groups. The application is available to all seniors at <http://fairfieldscholarshipfoundation.org/application/>.

Once you have completed the online application, students must submit two copies of the following to his/her school counselor:

- **Printout of Application Responses**, signed by you and your parent/guardian.
- **Student Aid Report (SAR) page with Expected Family Contribution (EFC) amount**, if you have completed a FAFSA. Scholarships that have financial need require a FAFSA to be filed and a SAR page to be attached to this application. Please submit **ONLY** the SAR page, not the entire FAFSA packet.
- **Essay** (500 word limit), explaining your desire to continue your education. You may include information that includes special interests, circumstances or obstacles you have overcome.
- **Letter of Recommendation** - A letter of recommendation from a teacher, coach, employer, or any unrelated adult (other than your school counselor). If you are utilizing a teacher's letter, your school counselor will attach it to your application. You must let your counselor know.


The student's school counselor will include the following once you submit your portion of the application:

- Letter of recommendation
- Transcript

DEADLINE: APRIL 23, 2018

Scholarship awards will be announced at the Senior Awards Night **tentatively** set for **Tuesday, June 19, 2018**. If you have any questions or concerns, please see your school counselor.
