What We're Learning In reading, we have started our new unit on Poetry. Students have been thinking about how an author's craft and use of language help readers deepen their understanding of poetry. We will be reading a variety of poems and working to articulate and support our interpretations of those poems. We have also started our poetry unit in writing. Throughout this unit, students will be collecting and writing poetry in a variety of styles. In math, we have completed our unit on fractions and will begin our new unit with a focus on measurement. Students will deepen their understanding of both standard and non-standard units of measurement. We will also discuss area, perimeter and elapsed time.
