How to help your child when reading

Here are some questions you can use to help monitor your child's comprehension when reading at home.

- 1. If you close your book, can you retell what you have just read?
- 2. Can you make a connection to the text you have just read?
- 3. Can you make a prediction as to what will happen next? Why do you think that will happen?
- 4. Can you tell me about the <u>story elements</u> in the text you have just read? Setting? Main characters? Problem? Solution?
- 5. What was your <u>favorite part</u> of the text you have read? What makes it your favorite?
- 6. What do you think the <u>lesson of the story</u> is? What do you think the character learned in this chapter?
- 7. What do you think the MOST IMPORTANT PART of the story was? Why?
