What We're Learning!

In reading, we began our character study unit by discussing how we can get to know characters in stories like they are our good friends. For example, we can study the way they talk, act, and interact.

In writing, we published and celebrated our amazing true stories! We are beginning our work on memoirs by analyzing the work of some fabulous authors including Cynthia Rylant.

In math, we completed our unit on place value by talking about strategies to add and subtract 3 digit numbers. Students also worked on adding and subtracting money by both using an algorithm and using a counting on strategy. We are starting our study of early multiplication and division concepts.

We are finishing our work on Native Americans by learning about "family memories" for a storytelling activity. Coming up soon, your child will be asking you to share some memories about important people, places or events.

We have a field trip on December 3rd to the Discovery Museum in Bridgeport. This will be our kickoff to our unit on matter.
