What We're Learning!

In reading, we ended our launch unit introducing reader's workshop in 3rd grade.

We started discussing how to read with wide-awake minds by discussing comprehension strategies such as predicting, visualizing, and questioning.

In writing, we have written our flash draft of our first piece. We have learned many strategies of how to revise our writing, such as looking at other authors' writing (famous or student), finding the heart of our story, and including internal thoughts and external actions to help in increasing elaboration.

In math, we started our unit on place value. We read a story called Grandma Eudora's T-Shirt Factory which relates to place value. We learned about how numbers (t-shirts) are bundled into tens (rolls) and hundreds (boxes). We have also worked on representing numbers in multiple ways.

We are knee-deep in our Native American research. We have used books, e-books, and folktales to guide our research. We will be synthesizing our research into a final project soon!
