In reading, we finished our informational reading unit with a final project. The students worked on ways to share what they have learned about non fiction text structures and features. They also presented their projects and gave compliments and friendly feedback to each other. This feedback and self-reflection are effective ways to improve their work. We have started our next reading unit which is fluency. In writing, we are finishing our work with informational writing and the students are typing their pieces at home. They have learned how authors choose certain ways to represent information and implemented it in their work. Our next unit will be poetry. In math, we are continuing our unit on fractions, working with parts of a whole and parts of a set. We also learned how to identify fractions on a number line and dividing objects into equal shares. Next week we will begin our new social studies unit on Asia.
