
1L's Weekly News - Week of January 13th

Reader's Workshop:

This week in Reader's Workshop we will begin our unit on **making connections**. We will practice making text to self connections (when something in a story reminds us of something from our lives) and talk about connecting to a character or an event. When your readers are reading at home, ask them about any connections they can make!

Writer's Workshop:

In Writer's Workshop we will continue our non-fiction unit. Our experts are doing a great job writing teaching books! This week we'll talk about adding "fancy and specific" words to our stories. (For example, if I wrote a book about penguins, I may use words like *Antarctica*, waddle, glacier, or adapt.) We'll also focus on revising our stories by adding or subtracting details, editing our work, and designing covers. Ask your writer what topic he/she is writing a book about!

Math:

This week in Math we'll continue our geometry unit. We'll sort and describe the plane shapes that we learned about last week. We'll also begin to explore 3D solids. We'll learn about: cone, pyramid, rectangular prism, cube, sphere, and cylinder.

Word Work: We'll continue the work we started next week.

Science/Social Studies:

This week we'll continue our LMC research all about Emperor Penguins. Ask your scientist what he/she has learned so far about these neat animals!
