Reader's Workshop:

In Reader's Workshop we will move into a new unit all about story elements. During this unit we'll work on identifying story elements and use these elements to increase comprehension and retell stories. This week we will learn about the characters and setting. When your reader is enjoying books at home, ask him/her to talk about these two story elements.

Writer's Workshop:

Last week we focused on ending punctuation. We learned about the importance of periods, exclamation points, and question marks, and how they help us end a sentence and stop our voices. This week we'll focus on using quotation marks in our writing.

Math:

* In Math this week we'll begin to learn about **fractions**. We'll learn about equal parts of a whole and talk about new vocabulary words: *numerator* and *denominator*.
