# Reader's Workshop:

This week in we will step back to revisit some of the routines of Reader's Workshop in 1L. We'll talk about expectations during reading time, book shopping, putting books away, and reading with partners.

# Writer's Workshop:

In Writer's Workshop we will continue our non-fiction unit. We'll focus on writing how-to books this week.

#### Math:

- \* In Math this week we'll begin to learn about **fractions**. We'll learn about equal parts of a whole and talk about new vocabulary words: *numerator* and *denominator*.
- \* A letter was sent home last week outlining a special geometry project due back to school by next Monday, February 3<sup>rd</sup>. Students are being asked to create a sculpture **at home**, using 3D objects (cone, sphere, pyramid, cube, cylinder, rectangular prism). Students can use any combination of these 3D solid figures, and do not have to use all of them. We want students to be creative with items they can reuse/recycle/repurpose from home. Please do not go out and purchase anything special for this project. For example, a city scene of skyscrapers made from various boxes (rectangular prisms) or a rocket ship made from an oatmeal container and paper towel tubes (cylinders) are examples of what they can do. This should be a fun extension of our study of geometry in the classroom!

### Word Work: continuation of last week's work

Our new Word Wall Words are: away, been, little, us, very.

\* This week we will focus on "magic e" words. For example, a says its name in the word make because of the silent e found at the end of the word.

# Science/Social Studies:

\* We've been watching some really neat videos featuring emperor penguins as part of our LMC research. You can watch these videos at home with your scientist, as they are on the Dwight website.
