Dates to Remember:

Reader's Workshop:

In Reader's Workshop we will continue our nonfiction unit of study. We will learn about section headings in nonfiction books and create our own headings to tell what a section is mostly about. Ask your reader what nonfiction books he/she has read so far!

Writer's Workshop:

In Writer's Workshop we will continue our nonfiction unit, as well. Our experts spent time last week brainstorming topics that they could write teaching books about. This week we'll talk about using pictures as well as works to teach a reader, and adding "fancy and specific" words to our stories. (For example, if I wrote a book about penguins, I may use words like *Antarctica*, waddle, or glacier.)

Math:

In Math we'll practice finding all of the combinations that make a number and focus on the concept of equivalence. (i.e. -3+5=4+4)

Word Work:

Our new Word Wall Words are: as, one, or, out, was.
