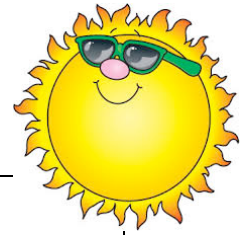


1L's Weekly News - Week of May 30th
