## Reader's Workshop:

We are officially launching Reader's Workshop in 1L this week! We'll set reading goals for ourselves, talk about the structure of Reader's Workshop, and learn how to "linger" in our books.

## Writer's Workshop:

Last week in Writer's Workshop we began our weekly tradition of Weekend News. Every Monday morning, students will write and draw about their weekends. This is an exciting way to continue to practice our writing skills and get to know each other!

#### Math:

We've been using graphs to learn all about each other. This week we'll practice taking surveys and tallying our results. We'll also begin our focus on **number sense** this week. One of the things we'll practice is *subitizing* numbers. Subitizing means "instantly seeing how many". For example, when you roll a die and can automatically tell that you rolled a five, instead of touching each dot and counting one-by-one, you are subitizing. This is a great skill for our mathematicians to have as they build their number sense.

#### Word Work:

In Word Work, we'll introduce five new Word Wall words each week. The words will be put on the Word Wall in our classroom and students will be expected to spell them correctly in their writing. We'll begin with a review of some of the words that students learned and practiced last year.
