Reading: This week we will learn the importance of rereading books for fluency. You can ask your child what fluency means ☺. We will also start talking about what different reading strategies great readers use!

Writing: We have been working on writing true stories about events that have happened or something that is important to us. We will continue our work with true stories, learning to zoom into a small moment. We will also focus on using the lines correctly when writing and keeping our stories organized. You can ask your child to tell you about a story they have written!

Math: We have been practicing our subitizing skills the last few weeks. This week we will be adding numbers to ten as well as composing teen numbers. We will be taking the iReady math assessment in the LMC on Tuesday and Wednesday.

Word Work: New words- can, my, we, up, at

We will be working with the -at word family. You can ask your child to tell you a word from this word family! All word wall words that we have reviewed so far this year are up on Spelling City for practice.
