Reading: Our focus this week will be making good book selections that are just right. We will discuss the difference between books that are too hard, too easy, and just right. Students will learn to recognize that in a just right book they know almost all the words and are reading fluently.

Writing: This week we will be working with partners! The students will practice how to be good listeners as well as learning how to add details to their writing based on partner feedback and questions.

Math: We will be focusing on various addition and subtraction strategies this week. We will learn to count back using a number line, practice our doubles facts and skip count. Have your child skip count by 5's to 100 for you!

Science: We have begun our investigation and discussion on shadows. Last week we took a walk to examine our own shadows! This week we will talk about why our shadows look different at various times throughout the day. We will also discuss our learning from our in school fieldtrip-High Touch/High Tech!

Word Work: New words- day, see, an, so, all
Word family practice: -an
