Reading: This week in our non-fiction unit of study we will read our non-fiction texts with a partner. We will also be reading some fun Thanksgiving books and discussing what we are thankful for!

Writing: Writers will continue working on their “teaching books” this week. We will focus on adding important details and editing our books for punctuation.

Math: The students will be using the math rack tool to begin doing subtraction. We will be playing a fun math game to begin our investigation!
