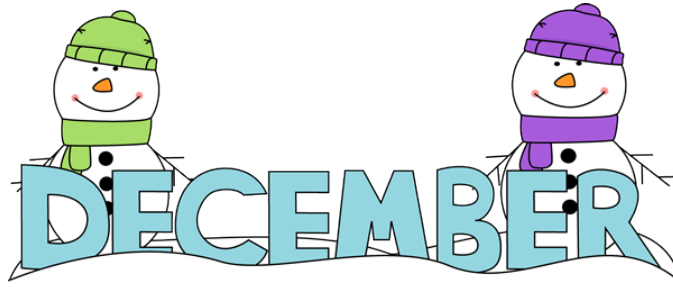


Here's what we are up to in 1K this week!

November 30th –December 4th



Reading: This week in our non-fiction unit of study we will focus on strategies to help us figure out the meaning of words in our non-fiction texts. We will be learning strategies such as rereading for clues in the text and checking the glossary to help us figure out unknown words in our texts. You can ask your reader what strategies they have used to help them figure out a word meaning in their text!

Writing: We are continuing with writing our teaching books this week. We will be learning how to make a table of contents for our books as well as introductions and conclusions. We will also spend some time learning different ways to teach our readers important information in our teaching books such as using comparisons.

Math: The students will continue to use the math rack as a tool to begin doing subtraction. We will also be learning how to write addition and subtraction story problems using the Double Decker Bus. You can ask your mathematician to tell you a story problem about the Double Decker Bus.

Social Studies: Thank you so much to Mr. McCormack for coming in to speak to 1K about cyber security and how to be safe on the Internet! The students have really enjoyed having parents join us to talk about their roles in our community. We are looking forward to more visitors in December!
