Here's what we are up to in 1K this week!

December 7th –December 11th



Reading: This week students we will be learning that great readers jot down notes as they read non-fiction texts. Some different things they may jot down are questions they have about the text, new ideas, or a connection they make to the text. Students will also learn to recognize the different voices we use as we read a non-fiction text vs. a fiction text.

<u>Writing:</u> Writers will be writing introductions and conclusions to their teaching books this week. We will also be sharing our writing with a partner to help one another add important details to our teaching books.

Math: In math, students will be learning about related facts and the relationship between addition and subtraction. We will be playing various games to help the students practice finding the solution to an addition problem, and then the related subtraction problem (6+4=10, 10-6=4). We will also begin learning to add 3 addends by grouping numbers together efficiently to solve each problem.

Social Studies: Thank you so much to Mrs. Stanton for coming in to speak to 1K about solar energy! The students really enjoy having parents come in to talk about their roles in our community. We have several visitor scheduled for this week! We still have spots available if you are interested in volunteering! ©

Word Work: Same words this week: back, get, her, him, his Word work focus: Short vowels
