Here's what we are up to in 1K this week!

January 25th -January 29th

<u>Reading:</u> We will continue our study of characters this week focusing on the main characters in the stories we are reading. We will get to know the main characters in our books by noticing what they say, do, and feel.

<u>Writing:</u> This week in our opinion writing we will be learning that if we want opinion our pieces to be strong and convincing to others, we should include important information about our topic. We will also be making comparisons in our opinion pieces.

<u>Math:</u> We are continuing our study of geometry this week by moving into learning about 3D shapes! We will learn about cones, cylinders, spheres, rectangular prisms, pyramids, and cubes. We will learn about the different attributes these 3D shapes have by looking at the faces (flat surfaces), vertices (corners), and edges (sides) they each have.

<u>Science</u>: We will continue learning about different habitats this week, and what animals need to have/do to survive in their habitat.

Word Work: New words: best, came, make, of, said

Word work focus: Magic (silent) "e"
