## Here's what we are up to in 1K this week!

January 4th –January 8th



**Reading:** This week we are starting a new unit called "Appreciating Fiction Through the Characters' Eyes". Students will practice previewing books by looking at the cover and pictures in books, and make predictions about the characters. We will also talk about different story elements this week including characters, setting, events, problems and solutions. You can ask your reader to tell you about the different story elements in their books they take home for homework this week!

**Writing:** We are starting our new "writing reviews" unit in writing this week! The students will be doing opinion writing in this unit. We will start by talking about what it means to be a judge and what an opinion is. We will also practice giving details and reasons for our own reviews to try and convince others.

<u>Math:</u> This week in math we will begin our geometry and fractions unit. We will spend time discussing the difference between defining and non-defining attributes of shapes. We will also describe and compare different shapes by their defining attributes (sides, angles, vertices, etc.)

**Science:** Our next science unit is all about living things. In the coming weeks, students will begin to learn what animals need to survive as well as different animal adaptations.

Word work focus: Blends (ex: bl, gr, cr, fl, st) and Digraphs (sh, ch, th, wh)
