Reading: We will launch our "Bringing Stories to Life Through Fairytales and Folktales" unit this week! We will spend time looking through various folktales and talk about what we notice as well as compare them to fiction stories. We will also identify the important events and characters in a story by using a plot mountain.

Writing: We will also be starting our new fiction unit in writing this week! Students will spend time planning out their fiction stories by creating a character and setting for their story. They will also spend time imagining and planning out the events that will take place in their story.

Math: This week in our place value unit students will be learning to subtract and add ten or one to a given number using a hundreds chart. We will also be playing some fun number riddle games to practice using our place value skills.
