5th grade

Students created **2D** to **3D** sculptures – you can find them in the school hallway.

The students are also painting and learning about **Value with tints and shades**.

Tints – are adding white / Shades – are adding black. The students are creating under the sea paints or natural landscapes.

In our next lesson we will be exploring **Architecture**... while also learning about the **famous artists Al Hirschfeld** and his New York Times newspaper drawings and **James Hancock's** illustrations in his book: All the Buildings in New York That I've Drawn So Far.

4th grade

We are now learning about an artist that creates art from looking at desserts! Yum... The students are learning how to draw - Form and Value
The artist- WAYNE THEIBAUD - POP ARTIST AND A REALISM ARTISTS
Pronunciation - Wayne Thiebaud - Wayne TEE-bo

In our next lesson we will be going 3D - and creating with CLAY!

3rd grade

The students learned about **Vincent Van Gogh..... The famous SUNFLOWERS** painting and the STARRY NIGHT painting. The students created gorgeous chalk drawings inspired by Van Gogh.

In our next lesson the students are going to learn about the famous **Japanes**e **artist Hokusai and woodblock print -The Great Wave.** Vincent Van Gogh was even inspired by this artist!

2nd grade

The students are creating **3D Paper Mache under the sea creatures**! We are working with carboard, tape, scissors, and lots of glue.

1st grade

We finished learning about abstract art and using geometric shapes and lines and are now learning about organic shapes and studying the SUPER famous artist Henri Matisse! Who -PAINTED WITH SCISSORS!! We are cutting and gluing....
MATISSE Inspired Painted Paper Collage!! In our next lesson we will learn about texture through printmaking with leaves in CLAY and on paper.

Kindergarten

We just finished our HUGE rainbow inspired flower paintings inspired by Georgia O'Keefe.

We watched a video on the book **Rainbow Fish**. The children's book is illustrated and written by Marcus Pfister. The students are creating a multi-medium lesson based on the Rainbow fish. We are creating a painted paper project – super fun with lots of paints... **Learning to paint with the colors -Blues, Greens, and the Rainbow order.** In our next lesson we will learn about MONDRIAN and the primary colors- Red, Yellow and Blue.
