COLLEGE AND CAREER CENTER

Visits begin on Monday, September 19 and will be held on the half hour for 30-minute sessions. They are open to all juniors and seniors. Students may be released from classes at the teacher's discretion. To attend a college visit, students will need to:

- 1. Sign up through Naviance *prior to* the day of the visit.
- 2. Check Naviance registration page for visit location.
- 3. Print out the Naviance registration page as their pass (the pass allows them to leave and return to your class).
- 4. Have the teacher sign the printed page and bring it to the College & Career Center *(students without a signed pass will not be admitted).*
- 5. Sign the attendance sheet (which is separate from the pass and confirms their attendance at the visit) in the CCC—failure to do so will result in a cut for that class.
- 6. Have their pass stamped at the CCC at the end of the visit and return immediately to class.
- 7. Students with a free period will not need a pass.

REMINDERS

LIBRARY LEARNING CENTER

- All textbook-related fines are processed by deans. Library fines are handled in the library.
- New books: Check out the book displays and "Book of the Week" bulletin board for the latest independent reading titles.
- Research help: Use the "Contact Us" link on the library page if you need help on a project and don't have time to come to the library.
- Access the library digital reference collection 24/7 by logging into the library catalog. Log on: first initial, last name. Password: student ID#.
- <u>FLHS SCHOOL STORE</u>: The Perch is located next to the cafeteria and is open Period 3 (all lunch waves) on days 1 and 2.
- <u>LIBRARY AND TEXTBOOK ACCOUNTS</u>: Check your library and textbook account by logging in to the library/textbook catalog. The link is on the library webpage. **Username:** network login (usually first initial and last name). **Password:** student ID number
- <u>STUDENT ACCESS TO THE BUILDING</u>: Students arriving at school after 8:10 a.m. need to show their student ID to be admitted to the building. Without an FLHS student ID, admission is at the front door. Students without an FLHS ID should expect to be questioned by the security guard.
- **<u>STUDENT ATTENDANCE</u>**: Parents must communicate with their HOUSE secretary when the student will be coming to school after 7:30 or leaving before 2:10.
- LEAVING SCHOOL BEFORE 2:10, COMING IN AFTER 7:30, or OUT FOR THE DAY: It is expected that students leaving school before 2:10 will leave class at the appropriate time and sign out in their house office without being paged. If getting picked up, students should wait on the front porch of the building. Students leaving school early need to have a note from a parent or guardian or the parent or guardian needs to have called the house secretary. All reports of absence should be relayed to the house secretary. Students arriving late need to sign in at the house office before reporting to class. A note or phone call should be directed to the house secretary explaining the tardiness.
