To calculate the different subject area GPA's:

- 1. In courses that you have **completed**, look at the **FINAL grade only**, and find the correct number value for that grade.
- 2. In your current class, find the correct number value for the SEMESTER GRADE.
- **3.** You are now going to calculate an average based on the number of credits for each of the classes. Full year final grades are counted twice because a full year course consists of two credits. A semester grade is only counted once as it represents only one credit.

Note the following example:

Grade 9: Geometry 21, Final grade A-. That is equal to a 4.0.

Grade 10: Algebra 31, Final grade A-. That is equal to a 4.0.

Grade 11: Pre-Calculus 41, SEMESTER grade, A. That is equal to a 4.33.

So, add (4.0 + 4.0) + (4.0 + 4.0) + 4.33 = the total, 20.33 should now be divided by the five total credits you took in math, equaling a math GPA of 4.07.
