SENIORS, WHAT'S YOUR PLAN NEXT YEAR?

Going to college?

- All students must meet with their counselors 3 weeks before their first deadline.
- Reminder <u>STUDENTS</u> are responsible for submitting their applications and test (SAT/ACT) scores.

First marking period grade requests

 Before turning in a first marking period grade request form, you MUST review your grades to ensure accuracy.
 Report cards will be available on IC 11/14, so no requests should be turned in before that date.

PSAT Scores Coming Soon!

Sophomores and juniors took the PSAT on October 11th. The official score release day is Monday, December 13th. Students can access their scores on their CollegeBoard account.

- Sophomores will be meeting with school counselors to review scores and confirm access to CollegeBoard accounts beginning in December.
- Juniors should all have access to both CollegeBoard and Khan Academy's SAT preparation program. Please see your school counselor with any questions.
