Each year, 30 high school students from around the state of Connecticut are selected to participate in this unique educational program where they learn from a variety of local, state, and federal law enforcement representatives and participate in hands-on demonstrations of polygraphs, fingerprint analysis, and more. The program runs July 15 - 21, 2018.
