To calculate the different subject area GPA's:

- 1. In courses that you have **completed**, look at the **FINAL grade only**, and find the correct number value for that grade.
- 2. In your current class, find the correct number value for the SEMESTER GRADE.
- **3.** You are now going to calculate an average based on the number of credits for each of the classes. Full year final grades are counted twice because a full year course consists of two credits. A semester grade is only counted once as it represents only one credit.

Note the following example: Say you are in Grade 11 applying for the math honor society:

Grade 9: You took Geometry 21, Final grade A. That is equal to a 4.33 and it's two credits for the full year.

Grade 10: Algebra 31, Final grade B+. That is equal to a 3.67 and it's two credits for the full year.

Grade 11: You are taking Pre-Calculus 41, SEMESTER grade, A-. That is equal to a 4.0 and one credit.

So, add (4.33 + 4.33) + (3.67 + 3.67) + 4.0 = 20.0 The total should now be divided by the five total credits you took in math so far, equaling a math GPA of 4.0.
