Dear FLHS Student and Parent,

Fairfield Ludlowe High School is one of 800 schools that will implement new AP classroom resources and registration processes this fall, a year before all other schools. As a student who is enrolled in at least one Advanced Placement (AP) course, I am sending you important AP information about these new changes.

General AP Exam Information

Taking the AP exams is an important part of all AP courses. Students enrolled in AP courses are expected to take the AP exam. Scoring well on an AP exam can often earn students college credit for their high school class, saving a significant amount on tuition. NEW Classroom Resources

At the beginning of the school year, AP students will complete a simple online enrollment process during class that will give them access to the new classroom resources. **Students should come to class with their College Board log-in information.** If a student needs assistance with logging into their account or are unsure if they have a College Board account, please call College Board at 844-314-3632 or visit <https://pages.collegeboard.org/account-help>.

NEW Registration Timeline

College Board has moved the registration process for AP exams to the **fall**. Therefore, students will need to decide to take their AP exam(s) much earlier than in previous years.

Payment Process

Students will continue to register for AP exams through Total Registration. Registration will open October 1, 2018.


Deadline to register is October 31, 2018.

NEW Fees

Each AP exam costs \$105 and payment is due by October 31, 2018. If a student wants to register for an exam after October 31, College Board charges a late fee of \$40 per exam. If a student decides to cancel an AP exam after November 15, 2018, there will be a fee of \$40 for each exam canceled. If a student decides to cancel an AP exam after March 1, 2019, the student will not receive a refund. **If a student qualifies for free/reduced lunch, please contact me for financial assistance.**
