Dear Senior,

The application for the High School Scholarship Foundation of Fairfield, Inc. will be available on line beginning Monday, March 25, 2019. This application is required to apply for a variety of scholarships from the Foundation and a number of local community groups. The application is available to all seniors at <http://fairfieldscholarshipfoundation.org/application/>.

Once you have completed the online application, students must submit **two** copies of the following to their school counselor:

- **Printout of Application Responses**, signed by you and your parent/guardian.
- **Student Aid Report (SAR) page with Expected Family Contribution (EFC) amount**, if you have completed a FAFSA. Scholarships that have financial need require a FAFSA to be filed and a SAR page to be attached to this application. Please submit **ONLY** the SAR page, not the entire FAFSA packet.
- **Essay** (500 word limit), explaining your desire to continue your education. You may include information that includes special interests, circumstances or obstacles you have overcome.
- **Letter of Recommendation** - A letter of recommendation from a teacher, coach, employer, or any unrelated adult (other than your school counselor). If you are utilizing a teacher's letter of recommendation, you must inform your school counselor so they can attach a copy to your application.

Once two copies of the above mentioned documents are submitted, your school counselor will **automatically include** their letter of recommendation and a copy of your transcript to your application.

DEADLINE: APRIL 23, 2019

Scholarship awards will be announced at the Senior Awards Night **tentatively** scheduled for **Wednesday, June 12, 2019**. If you have any questions or concerns, please see your school counselor.
