Welcome to Fairfield Ludlowe High School! This document holds important information for you and your parents about two important dates **prior to** the start of school that will help you get ready for a great year. Please read it carefully and save for future reference.

Attending Fairfield Ludlowe will be a fantastic experience for you. You will face new academic challenges, make new friends, try new activities, overcome obstacles, and take advantage of new opportunities. Your teachers, counselors, and administrators are here to help you accomplish all these things. It all begins in a few weeks, and to help you get ready we invite you to some helpful information sessions. **SAVE THESE DATES!**

1. **Preview Day** on Wednesday, August 21, 2019—for *all* new FLHS students, and parents grades 9—12.
2. **Freshman Orientation** on Wednesday, August 28, 2019—for grade 9 students only.

Here is what you need to know about each day:

**PREVIEW DAY – August 21 (for all new students AND parents):** We are scheduling three separate meeting times based on your house assignment. Every student is assigned to a “house” for all four years at FLHS-- either Warner, Webster, or Wright. Each house will meet at a different time, so you must come at the assigned time in order to meet your housemaster, dean, and school counselor. Your house assignment was sent in an email. The auditorium is by the front entrance of the school. You will receive your schedule, a packet of information, and be greeted by administrators, deans, and counselors. **Students** will be given a tour of the building by our Ludlowe Leaders (Grade 11 students), have questions answered, and get your ID picture taken. You will also receive some of your textbooks and a Chromebook, so **bring a backpack or bag** to get them home. **Parents** will get a chance to ask their own questions.

The Preview session will take about 60 minutes. If you cannot make the session, please notify the Main Office (203-255-7200), and you can pick up your schedule and information after August 21.

**FRESHMAN ORIENTATION – August 28, 7:30 a.m. – 11:30 a.m. (all Grade 9 students only)**

Report to your assigned homeroom at 7:30 a.m. and make sure to bring the schedule you received on the Preview Day or from Infinite Campus. This will be a half-day event to give you an opportunity to meet your teachers and follow your schedule before classes officially begin on the next day. You will also receive important information from your homeroom teacher as well as a student agenda/planner. You only need to bring a pen or pencil. Aquaculture students can attend this session since they do not start at Aqua until August 29. A picnic-style lunch, sponsored by our PTA, will be provided on the front lawn at 11:10.

There is **NO BUS SERVICE** provided on this day, so please make transportation arrangements. Students can be picked up at 11:10 if they won't be having lunch or 11:30 if staying for lunch.

**If you cannot attend, please report to your counseling office on August 29 (the first day) when you first arrive at school to receive your updated schedule.**
