UCONN ECE STUDENTS

Students that have not yet submitted their online application may do so through September 15th. Students with processed applications may add or drop courses from their ECE schedule until September 30th. No further registration activity will be allowed after September 30, 2016. Students wishing to withdraw from their ECE course after September 30th must submit a WAU form which can be found on UCONN's website.

Other reminders:

- An additional \$25 add/drop fee is assessed during the August 15- September 30th cycle. This fee is in addition to regular course fees.
- Students that drop courses by September 30th deadline will receive a refund of paid fees minus the \$25 add/drop fee.
- Any students submitting a WAU form after September 30th is responsible for all course fees.

POLICY ON CHANGE OF PROGRAM

A great deal of time and effort on the part of the staff is devoted to developing an individual program for each student. It is also essential that students and parents put sufficient time and thought into the process of selecting appropriate courses to assure a satisfactory program. Attention to course prerequisites and requirements is important. There are few legitimate reasons for making program changes during the school year. Any program elected should be started with the idea of completion in mind; trying a class for a while and then dropping it is not allowed. Once a student has selected a schedule, class changes are not permitted unless it is a teacher recommended change. As always, students with concerns regarding their academic program should speak to their teacher and school counselor.

*After the first marking period of a course, any **approved** changes will result in a grade of "W" (withdrawn) to appear on the student transcript: this includes a change in the level of a course.*

There will be *no* course changes in the first two weeks of school. Counselors will make changes only for the following reasons:

1. Incomplete schedule or insufficient credits.
2. A course scheduled in error by the school.
3. Changes needed as the result of courses failed in June.
4. Changes needed as the result of successful completion of summer school.
