### **UConn Early College Experience**

Add/Drop Period is August 15, 2017 – September 29, 2017

A \$25 non-refundable processing fee is charged during the add/drop registration period. This fee is in addition to the program fees listed above. Courses must be dropped online in the Compass Enrollment Center on or before September 29, 2017 to result in a refund of already paid program fees minus the \$25 processing fee. Courses dropped after September 29, 2017, will require a WAU (withdrawn audit) form to be completed and all course fees to be paid.

### **Who Gets In and Why: A Behind-the-Scenes Look at the Selective Admissions Process**

Wednesday, September 27, 2017 @ 6:30 PM, Fairfield Warde HS

Ever wonder what *really* happens inside the highly selective college admissions process? **Who Gets In And Why**, an interactive workshop designed by the Tufts University Office of Undergraduate Admissions, aims to show you. First, attendees will learn about the different components of a college application, and how those materials are evaluated by admissions offices. Next, everyone will participate in a case study designed to resemble the admissions process, featuring six real applications from prior Tufts applicants. **Who Gets In And Why** is a rare opportunity to get an inside look at what happens once applications are submitted.
