FREE FAFSA WORKSHOP FOR 12TH GRADE PARENTS

We are pleased to offer an opportunity for 12th grade parents/guardian(s) to attend a FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) workshop with Ms. Holly Franquet, Director of the College Place-CT. The FAFSA is the main financial aid form used by colleges to determine the amount of financial aid offered to students.

These workshops will be held in the College & Career Center (P-38) on Thursday January 12, 19 and 26 at the following times: 8:30-9:30, 9:30-10:30 and 1:00-2:00. There will be four families in each workshop. To complete the FAFSA, you will need:

<u>Student</u>: Social Security number, date of birth, permanent resident number (if not a U.S. citizen), and 2015 tax return & W-2s (if applicable)

<u>Parent(s)</u>: Social Security numbers, dates of birth, month/year of latest marital status (married, separated, divorced, or widowed), and 2015 tax return & W-2s (if applicable)

Before your appointment, the student and one parent should go to <u>https://fsaid.ed.gov</u> and make FSA IDs. Please bring the user names and passwords with you.
