NOTES:

- No mini periods will have exams
- All morning buses run on the usual schedule.
- Dismissal/afternoon buses are at 11:55; there are no late buses.
- Students do not need to report to school if they do not have a scheduled exam.
- Second semester (3rd marking period) begins on Wednesday, January 25, 2017 pending snow day adjustment. It will be a Day 1. There is no “review day.”
- Aquaculture students attend Aquaculture during morning exam periods and will be picked up early enough to be back in time for the second exam of the day.

SNOW DAY CONSIDERATIONS PRIOR TO EXAMS

- If there is 1 snow day or 2 snow days on opposite schedules (e.g. One Day 2, One Day 3) prior to the start of midterms, the schedule will remain as is. If there are **2 or more** snow days that apply to the same Day rotation (e.g. Two Day 1’s), then we will push the exam schedule back a day (exams would start on Friday, 1/20). The added instructional day would be changed to match the day rotation that was lost. For example, if two Day 2’s were cancelled, 1/19 would be scheduled as a Day 2.

Throughout the week of December 12-16, during Social Studies classes with the School Counseling Department, all sophomores and juniors completed *Do What You Are*, a self-discovery personality type assessment. ### ***FREE FAFSA WORKSHOP FOR 12TH GRADE PARENTS***

We are pleased to offer an opportunity for 12th grade parents/guardian(s) to attend a FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) workshop with Ms. Holly Franquet, Director of the College Place-CT. The FAFSA is the main financial aid form used by colleges to determine the amount of financial aid offered to students.

**These workshops will be held in the College & Career Center (P-38) on Thursday January 12, 19 and 26 at the following times: 8:30-9:30, 9:30-10:30 and 1:00-2:00.** There will be four families in each workshop.

To complete the FAFSA, you will need:

Student: Social Security number, date of birth, permanent resident number (if not a U.S. citizen), and 2015 tax return & W-2s (if applicable)

Parent(s): Social Security numbers, dates of birth, month/year of latest marital status (married, separated, divorced, or widowed), and 2015 tax return & W-2s (if applicable)

Before your appointment, the student and one parent should go to <https://fsaid.ed.gov> and make FSA IDs. Please bring the user names and passwords with you.
