1955- In Montgomery, Alabama, Rosa Parks is jailed on this day for refusing to give up her seat on a public bus to a white man, a violation of the city's racial segregation laws. The Montgomery Bus Boycott, organized by Martin Luther King, Jr. following Park's historic act of civil disobedience, stretched for more than a year. On December 20, 1956, Montgomery's buses were finally desegregated.
