Dear Fairfield Warde High School Community,

This letter is to inform you that there will be an asbestos abatement project at Fairfield Warde High School located at 755 Melville Avenue, in Fairfield, CT beginning on December 28, 2015 through January 3, 2016. The abatement project includes the removal and disposal of pipe insulation, hot water storage tank insulation, from the boiler room.

The on-site consultant will be Hygenix, Inc.
The abatement contractor will be AAIS.
The abatement will take place while there are no children under the age of 18 in the building.

Hygenix, Inc will be on site for full time monitoring during the abatement performing visual inspections and conducting daily air monitoring. All air samples collected during this asbestos abatement project will be analyzed on a daily basis by a laboratory certified by the DPH.

Upon completion of abatement in each area, re-occupancy clearance air samples will be obtained to assure that the State of Connecticut-Department of Public Health's re-occupancy criteria have been met.
