IMPORTANT DETAILS

Senior Prom

- Saturday, May 31, 2014 7:00-11:00 \$45 per person
- Vazzano's Four Seasons (337 Kenyon Street Stratford, CT)
- Tickets will be on sale Monday, May 12th through Thursday, May 15th after school in T-11 (Gomes). All signed forms, payments, and seating arrangement forms are due at this point.
- Forms can be found outside of T-11 (Gomes) and T-26 (Nartowicz), in the Main Office, and on the FWHS website.
- If students are traveling to prom in a limo or bus, please be sure to check with the company to make sure the vehicles are properly registered and insured in Connecticut.

Graduation Rehearsals

- June 17th
 - Graduation rehearsal begins at 10:30 in the auditorium.
 - Students will receive their cap and gown during the rehearsal. Students will not be allowed to get their cap and gown if they have library, athletic, or other obligations due.
 - Class of 2014 Picnic will follow rehearsal in the Courtyard. Students can expect to stay until 2:00.
- June 18th
 - Graduation rehearsal begins at 10:30 in the auditorium.
 - Students will receive their tickets for graduation during this rehearsal.
 - Students can expect to stay until 1:00.

Graduation Caps & Gowns

- At the request of the members of the Class of 2014 Club, this year the class will wear caps and gowns that reflect our school colors. The colors will be the same as those of the Battle of the Houses:
Pequot – red Townsend – white Fitts – black
- Caps and gowns will be distributed at Graduation Rehearsal on June 17th.

Senior Gradation Speech

- Students who are interested in being considered for the Class of 2014 speaker at graduation must submit their speech to Ms. Gomes by June 6th.
