### **PSAT SCORES – Important Information for Students in Grades 10 & 11 and their Parents**

- PSAT scores will be available to students online on January 7th. The original time frame was mid-December, however College Board has delayed their release until January 7, 2016.
- In order to access PSAT scores, students will need a College Board account. During the next two weeks, School Counselors will meet with students during their lunch period in order to establish College Board accounts as well as an account with Khan Academy for free SAT practice.
- On December 16th, during Advisory period, students will receive information about how to interpret their PSAT results.
- On January 7<sup>th</sup> students will be able to log into their College Board account and view their PSAT scores.
- On January 20th, schools will receive a paper copy of students' PSAT results. There will be a notice posted on IC when these results are distributed to students.
