<u>PSAT SCORES – Important Information for Students in Grades 10 & 11 and their Parents</u>

- <u>We have contacted College Board and have been told that FWHS PSAT scores have not been</u> posted. We will update you when the scores are made available.
- In order to access PSAT scores, students will need a College Board account. During the next two weeks, School Counselors will meet with students during their lunch period in order to establish College Board accounts as well as an account with Khan Academy for free SAT practice.
- On December 16th, during Advisory period, students will receive information about how to interpret their PSAT results.
- On January 20th, schools will receive a paper copy of students' PSAT results. There will be a notice posted on IC when these results are distributed to students.
