#### PSAT SCORES-Important Information for Students in Grades 10 & 11 and their Parents

- We are continuing to work with College Board to obtain our PSAT scores. CB has not provided us with any rationale as to why we have not received the scores, only that they are working to get us our scores as quickly as possible. It appears that some students may have access to their scores while others do not. The district does not have access to any Warde scores.
- In order to access PSAT scores when they become available, students will need a College Board account. School Counselors have already met with students to establish College Board accounts as well as an account with Khan Academy for free SAT practice.
- The latest information from CB is that schools should receive a paper copy of students PSAT results on January 30th. There will be a notice posted on IC when these results are distributed to students.
- We thank you for your patience and will update you with any information as it becomes available.
