ATTENTION JUNIORS

Each year the Governor appoints two students entering their senior year to serve for one year as non-voting members of the Connecticut State Board of Education. Student board members participate fully in discussions about education policy and provide an important perspective to the state board. In order to be considered for an appointment students must:

- be enrolled in a public high school
- have at least a B+ GPA
- have completed 11th grade by June, 2015
- be able to attend monthly all-day meetings in Hartford (usually the first Wednesday of the month)

Applications are available in the main office and must be postmarked no later than March 16, 2015.
