CAPT SCIENCE - FOR ALL 10TH GRADERS

The Connecticut Academic Performance Test in science will be given to all sophomores on **March 15** during the first two periods of the day. Demonstrated proficiency on this test is a graduation requirement of the Fairfield Board of Education. Science teachers are providing students with practice materials that will familiarize them with the format of the test and will identify the content that will be covered on the test. Students should contact their science teacher or school counselor with any questions.

- Relax.
