1920 – In a 49-35 vote, the U.S. Senate fails to ratify the Treaty of Versailles, and with that rejects the League of Nations and other initiatives pushed on Europe by President Woodrow Wilson. Whether ratification might have prevented World War II is still a matter of controversy among historians.

ATTENTION JUNIORS

Each year the Governor appoints two students entering their senior year to serve for one year as non-voting members of the Connecticut State Board of Education. - be enrolled in a public high school
- have at least a B+ GPA
- have completed 11th grade by June, 2015
- be able to attend monthly all-day meetings in Hartford (usually the first Wednesday of the month)
