TO STUDENTS & PARENTS: RE: UCONN ECE COURSES

Procedures: Students who have already successfully submitted a 2015-2016 online application DO NOT need to submit any additional paperwork to ECE to add or drop a course. To add or drop courses these students must sign into the Compass Online Enrollment Center with their Net ID and password and update their record. To access the Compass Online Enrollment Center go to: ece.uconn.edu>Students>4.Enroll in Courses.

Instructions to drop a course can be found at: ece.uconn.edu>Students>Add/Drop Courses.

Students who have not yet submitted a 2015-2016 online application must do so prior to enrolling in courses.

Please use the enclosed **Registration Guide and Consent Form** only for students who have not yet applied.

New online applications must be submitted by **September 15, 2015**. Additional Consent Forms can be printed from ece.uconn.edu >Students>1.Consent Form. A \$25 non-refundable processing fee is charged during the add/drop registration period.

POLICY ON CHANGE OF PROGRAM

A great deal of time and effort on the part of the staff is devoted to developing an individual program for each student. It is also essential that students and parents put sufficient time and thought into the process of selecting appropriate courses to assure a satisfactory program. Attention to course prerequisites and requirements is important. There are few legitimate reasons for making program changes during the school year. Any program elected should be started with the idea of completion in mind; trying a class for a while and then dropping it is not allowed. Once a student has selected a schedule, class changes are not permitted unless it is a teacher recommended change. As always, students with concerns regarding their academic program should speak to their teacher and school counselor.

*After the first marking period of a course, any **approved** changes will result in a grade of "W" (withdrawn) to appear on the student transcript: this includes a change in the level of a course.*

There will be *no* course changes in the first two weeks of school. Counselors will make changes only for the following reasons:

1. Incomplete schedule or insufficient credits.
2. A course scheduled in error by the school.
3. Changes needed as the result of courses failed in June.
4. Changes needed as the result of successful completion of summer school.

Step 1: Access Family Connection/Naviance

Note: If you forgot your password, the Username = s/b the first letter of your first name and last name. Password = Student Number

Step 2: Schedule Your Visit

- ✓ Select the "colleges" tab
- ✓ Select "*view all upcoming college visits*"
 - You will now see a list of FWHS scheduled college visits
- ✓ Pick a school you would like to sign up for.
- ✓ Select "*sign up*"
 - You will now see the details for the college visit.
- ✓ Select "Sign me up" if you would like to attend this college visit.

Step 3: Create Your Pass

- ✓ After you select "Sign me up", you will see a confirmation notice.
- ✓ **Print this page, which is your pass.**
- ✓ **Bring the pass to your teacher and ask them to sign it.**

- ✓ **Put your name on the pass and bring this to the College & Career Resource Center when you attend the information session.**
- ✓ Remember to sign the attendance sheet at the information session otherwise you will receive a cut from your class.
