1967 – In Washington, D.C. nearly 100,000 people gathered to protest the American war effort in Vietnam. The protest was the most dramatic sign of the waning U.S. support for President Lyndon B. Johnson's war in Vietnam. The protesters were not simply questioning America's conduct in Vietnam but the very basis of the nation's Cold War policy.
