ATTENTION SENIORS -COMMON APPLICATION

Students using the Common Application to apply to colleges should be aware of this:

All application payments are processed by a third-party vendor. In some instances, a record of payment is not transmitted back to an applicant's Common App account. <u>This makes it appear to the applicant that the payment has not gone through when in fact it has.</u> We have a daily process in place that reconciles the vendor's payment records with our own. Unfortunately, we are discovering that some applicants are paying a second time before we are able to update the original payment record in their account. We are working closely with our payment vendor on a solution.

Given the issues that some students experienced with the payment submission process, we want to help ensure that all students who think they have submitted an application have actually submitted. Please have your students confirm that their applications have been submitted by checking their Dashboard. There will be a green check mark in the "Application" column for each submitted application.
