FINANCIAL AID NIGHT

On Thursday, November 21, 2013 at 7:00pm, the Counseling Departments of Fairfield Ludlowe and Fairfield Warde High School will hold a Financial Aid night for the parents of all senior students. Ms. Kelly Jambo-- Director of Aid for First Year and Transfer students at Sacred Heart University will speak. A veteran financial aid officer, Ms. Jambo will provide a power point presentation on the various types of aid available to seniors entering college in the fall. She will review the method used by most colleges to determine a family's need, the various types of aid available, and explain how the schools determine how to award aid to a family. She will review a broad range of financial options for students and parents. Mrs. Jambo will also review the FAFSA-- Free Application of Federal Student Aid. This is the primary form required by most colleges and universities to determine need and awards. After Ms. Jambo's presentation, she will provide ample time for questions and discussions.

The evening will be held in the auditorium of Fairfield Ludlowe High School, 785 Unquowa Road starting at 7:00 p.m. While the program is geared to seniors and their parents, the parents of underclassmen are welcome to attend to gain some initial understanding of the financial aid process.

SCHOOL COUNSELING, COLLEGE, AND CAREER NEWS

ATTENTION SENIORS – ANY STUDENT APPLYING VIA THE COMMON APPLICATION

Earlier this week I sent an inquiry to colleges and universities asking how they are addressing the problems with the new Common Application. Colleges are dealing with the common application issues in a variety of ways, some have extended their early decision and early action deadlines, some have posted messages on their websites, some are contacting their applicants by phone or email with specific directions, and others are waiting to see if these issues are resolved by this weekend. I encourage seniors, especially those who submitted early decision or early action applications, to check their college's website regularly for information or contact the admissions office directly if you are uncertain if your materials and payment have arrived in time. We are processing all applications and materials submitted to our offices in time for November 1 and 15th deadlines—if the materials were submitted on time to us. Please keep your School Counselor informed of any potential problems. Problems with the Common Application site should be addressed through their *Help Center* directly. Common Application reports that all issues should be resolved shortly.

Error Page upon Submission. On occasion, an applicant may see an error page upon submission. If this happens, the applicant should log out of his or her account and then log back in and go the Dashboard. The Dashboard should display confirmation that the application was submitted despite the error message observed during the submission process. The problem is with the page redirect, not the actual submission. We are working to fix this issue.
