FINANCIAL AID NIGHT

On Thursday, November 21, 2013 at 7:00pm, the Counseling Departments of Fairfield Ludlowe and Fairfield Warde High School will hold a Financial Aid night for the parents of all senior students. Ms. Kelly Jambo-Director of Aid for First Year and Transfer students at Sacred Heart University will speak. A veteran financial aid officer, Ms. Jambo will provide a power point presentation on the various types of aid available to seniors entering college in the fall. She will review the method used by most colleges to determine a family's need, the various types of aid available, and explain how the schools determine how to award aid to a family. She will review a broad range of financial options for students and parents. Mrs. Jambo will also review the FAFSA-Free Application of Federal Student Aid. This is the primary form required by most colleges and universities to determine need and awards. After Ms. Jambo's presentation, she will provide ample time for questions and discussions.

The evening will be held in the auditorium of Fairfield Ludlowe High School, 785 Unquowa Road starting at 7:00 p.m. While the program is geared to seniors and their parents, the parents of underclassmen are welcome to attend to gain some initial understanding of the financial aid process.
