1773 – The Boston Tea Party

On this day a group of Massachusetts colonists disguised as Mohawk Indians board three British tea ships and dump 342 chests of tea in the Boston harbor in protest of the British Parliament's Tea Act of 1773, a bill designed to save the faltering East India Company by greatly lowering its tea tax and granting it a virtual monopoly on the American Tea trade.
