#### **ATTENTION SENIORS**

<u>Common App Submission Doesn't End With Payment</u>: The submission process is a three-step sequence. First, students review a copy of their application. Second, they pay the application fee (unless using a fee waiver). Finally, they sign the affirmation and complete submission. Some students are stopping this sequence after paying the application fee but before submitting the application. For this reason, it's always a good idea for students to check their Dashboard for confirmation of submission status.

SAT prep - Nov. 19 - Jan. 21 Tues & Thurs 3-5pm at FLHS

ACT prep - Dec. 12 - Feb. 6 Thurs 3-5pm at FLHS

SAT Prep - Jan. 11 - Mar. 1, Saturdays, 11am-1pm at FLHS

SAT Prep - Jan. 15 - Mar. 5, Wed 5:30pm-7:30 at FLHS

We will have a practice SAT test on Feb 22 at Ludlowe and April 5 at Warde (open to all students regardless of which school they attend) and a practice ACT on Mar 22 at Warde. If your son is a junior, it's a good idea to get as much practice as possible before sitting for the real exam. FYI, the exams do not include the writing section. Cost is \$25 for any non-AlphaPrep student, free if you have ever or are registered to take a class in the future. To register for AlphaPrep classes or practice exam, log on to <a href="www.alphaprep.com">www.alphaprep.com</a> (type FPHS in the course code window.) Note that the upcoming classes will take place at Ludlowe High School, but all Fairfield public school students are encouraged to sign up regardless of which high school you attend.
